Hand Heart Pocket's Hardship Assistance program

Money problems or financial hardship can affect anyone at any time, but you may not always know what options are available to help you improve your financial wellbeing.

Hand Heart Pocket's financial hardship program brings the right people together to ensure you get the information and advice you need to get back on track with your finances as quickly as possible.

Experts in financial counselling

As part of this program Hand Heart Pocket is proud to partner with financial counselling and education experts, UnitingCare, to provide support to individuals in the community.

Through this partnership, people referred by Hand Heart Pocket and its Members will be prioritised for rapid uptake into UnitingCare's financial counselling and education service.

Benefits of the program

- You will be contacted quickly, usually within 72 hours of referral to UnitingCare, with a mutually convenient appointment scheduled within two weeks
- Access to the service is flexible, with appointments arranged face-to-face, by phone or via virtual platforms
- The support provided is free, independent, confidential and tailored to your personal circumstances, financial situation and aspirations
- On the recommendation of UnitingCare's Financial Counsellors, Hand Heart Pocket may also be able to offer a one-off financial hardship grant
